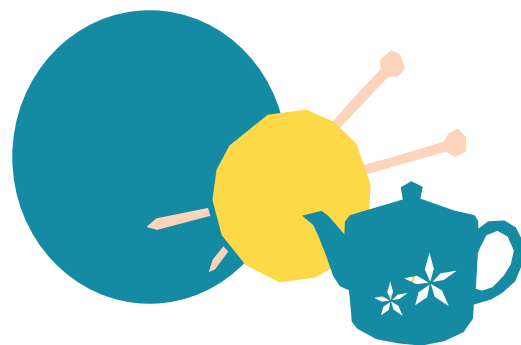

## **Life Drawing**

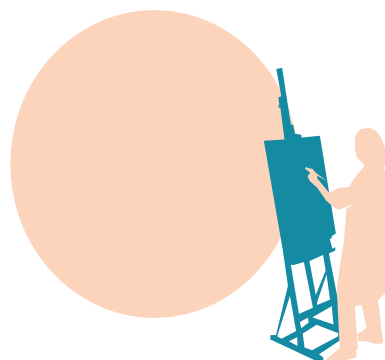
1st Saturday of the month\*, 2 - 4pm, £5

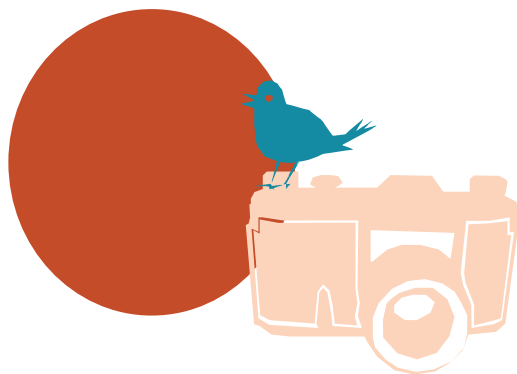

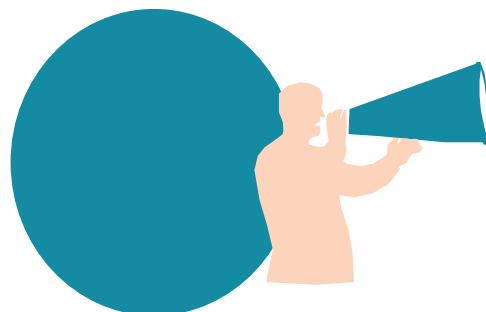

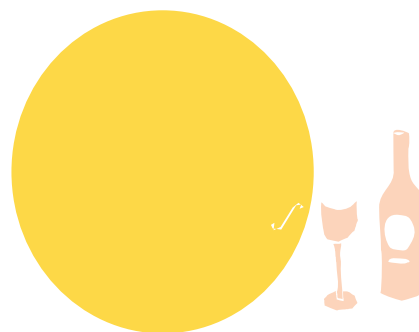
